The Colorado Historical Society produces publications for its members and anyone else with a passion for the history of Colorado and the West.

The bimonthly newsmagazine *Colorado Heritage* pairs announcements of Society programs, member happenings, and the latest in historic preservation with feature-length articles on the people and events of the past that have left their mark on today's Colorado. The Society publishes a monthly e-newsletter, *Colorado History Now*, to update its members on the latest in talks, tours, treks, exhibits, and what's going on at the Colorado History Museum and the Society's regional museums and properties.

The Society's scholarly journal began publication in 1982 as a series of article-length and book-length manuscripts on the history of Colorado and the Rocky Mountain West. Today the *Colorado History* series includes irregular volumes of biography and scholarly essays along with collections of symposium papers and titles produced in conjunction with Society exhibitions. The Society publishes other books and a series of capsule histories on its regional museums, and has produced brochures and booklets on its exhibits, general interest historical studies, exhibition catalogs, and directories and indexes to assist researchers and historians.
